## How to find us

Kingston Park Stadium is only five miles from Newcastle city centre, three miles from Newcastle International Airport, two minutes' drive from the A1 and a five-minute walk from Kingston Park and Bank Foot Metro stations.



### **Driving** (directions from the A1)

- Take the Airport exit
- At the roundabout take the exit signposted for Kingston Park
- Go straight over two roundabouts, under the Metro bridge and take the first right onto Brunton Road
- After 400 metres the stadium is on your left

### **By Metro**

Kingston Park Stadium is served by Kingston Park and Bank Foot Metro stations, both of which are a five-minute walk away. Both stations are on the Airport branch of the Tyne and Wear Metro.

### **By Bus**

Local bus services operate in the Kingston Park area, with connections including the X47 to and from Newcastle city centre.
